

Getting to know your water meter

The most convenient way to monitor your water usage is to read the water meter. The meter pictured on this page is similar to the one installed in your home. The meter is usually located inside the house along an outside wall. Read the numbers along the top of the meter to calculate your water consumption. Read the 6 digit numbers from left to right as you would a car odometer. (The final digit "zero" is permanent)

Your water meter leak detector can be the best tool in detecting leaks and preventing high bills...

If the leak detector on your meter is moving when no water is being used, you probably have a leak. Drips and slow leaks can be costly.

* To test for leaks turn off all the water including your ice maker.



This is the advanced, high resolution model water meter. You may already have this newer model installed in your home.

To read this meter, simply shine a flashlight over the sensor and you will see the 9-digit numbers appear on the LCD panel.

Leak detection...

With this model, you will see a flashing faucet icon which would indicate you have a leak. A solid faucet icon would indicate that you have had a continuous leak in the past 24 hours.
