



The upgrades and improvements to 27 pump stations in Mount Laurel Township, NJ was financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB) in the amount of \$4,349,719.23. The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide benefits by allowing the Authority's operational personnel to monitor the operation of the stations remotely and continuously, thereby greatly reducing the possibility of the discharge of untreated sewage for the residents and businesses in Mount Laurel Township.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
